

## OZHARVEST FEAST ONLINE LEARNING

Welcome to FEAST Online Learning.

We have reviewed the classroom-based program and developed a series of 8 interactive lessons to allow students to complete the theory aspect of the FEAST program at home.

The FEAST online learning program takes students on the journey of understanding what food waste is, how food is produced, what is healthy eating and what they can do to become change-makers. They will find answers to these questions while developing a recipe that addresses healthy eating and food waste avoidance.

### Using the Online Learning Resources

The resources can be provided to students in a variety of ways to suit your students' needs and access.

- **Share** the [OzHarvest FEAST "Student Portal"](#) through your online communication platform and direct students to the Online Learning tab. The student resources (8 lessons in total) are editable PDF's so students can type their answers directly into the document.
- **Download** the PDF lessons available in the [OzHarvest FEAST "Teacher Portal"](#) Online Learning tab and upload them to your teaching platform (Google classroom or the like).
- **Download** the PDF lessons available in the [OzHarvest FEAST "Teacher Portal"](#) Online Learning tab, print the resources and send them home as paper work booklets.

### Requirements

The online learning resources will require students to have:

- **Access to internet** to undertake online research and watch various educational videos.
- For the students using the FEAST PDF's available on the [OzHarvest FEAST "Student Portal"](#) , they will require access to a **PDF reader program** such as Adobe Acrobat Reader or Google Docs.
