
WHY DO WE NEED TO FIGHT FOOD WASTE?





THERE IS ENOUGH FOOD IN THE WORLD TO FEED EVERYONE ...

But one third of all food produced goes to waste.



... YET 1 IN 9 PEOPLE DO NOT HAVE ENOUGH TO EAT

That's over 828 million people.



FOOD WASTE FEEDS CLIMATE CHANGE


Wastes food in landfill creates a toxic gas called Methane

3.7 trillion apples are wasted each year?






IN AUSTRALIA 7.6 MILLION TONNES OF FOOD IS WASTED...
